Dear Applicant,

The Broome & Allen Boys Association was founded more than 60 years ago by a small group of young enterprising Sephardic men whose aim was to provide a summer vacation for young children who did not have the opportunity to escape the hot, humid summers of New York City. Over time the focus of the fund has shifted to assisting young people with college scholarships. These scholarships are now available to undergraduate and graduate students of Sephardic heritage and students pursuing Sephardic studies.

We feel it is important to show interest in our Sephardic people and to pass on this concern to the next generation. It is our hope that by providing this award, it will encourage Sephardic youth to be proud of our Sephardic heritage and to continue involvement in Sephardic culture well past their college career.

The application for a scholarship award for the 2011-2012 school year is enclosed. For consideration, the American Sephardi Federation must receive the completed application and all transcripts by **May 15, 2011**. Final transcripts should be sent after spring semester 2011. Awards will be made before the beginning of the fall semester.

Guidelines for Completing the Broome & Allen Scholarship Application

Criteria:

The Broome and Allen Scholarship is awarded to students of Sephardic origin or those working in Sephardic studies. Both graduate and undergraduate degree candidates as well as those doing research projects will be considered. It is awarded for one year and must be renewed for successive years. The student or researcher does not have to be living in the United States or be a U.S. citizen, but should be doing their studies or work in the U.S.

APPLICATION FORMS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MAY 15, 2011

Application Requirements:

Your completed application must include the following materials:

- Two (2) letters of recommendation; at least one must be an academic reference.
- Copy of the 2010 Federal Income Tax Return (or its international equivalent if applicable) of the applicant or parent/guardian.
- Official school transcripts (see details below) through the Fall 2010 semester. Transcripts must be official originals and sent directly from the school(s) to ASF and must be received and/or postmarked by **May 15, 2011**. Transcripts for the Spring 2011 semester must also be submitted (although not with the applications packet), and must be received and/or postmarked by **JUNE 30th**.
- We also recommend submitting a personal statement

Transcript Requirements:

College students who have not completed at least two (2) years of college must include:

- High School transcripts (unless previously submitted)
- Transcripts from all Colleges attended through the Fall 2010 semester

College students who have completed two (2) or more years of college must include:

- Transcripts from all Colleges attended through the Fall 2010 semester

Graduate students who have not completed at least two (2) years of graduate school must include:

- Transcripts from all Colleges attended (unless previously submitted)
- Transcripts from all Graduate School through the Fall 2010 semester

Graduate students who have completed two (2) or more years of graduate school must include:

- All Graduate School transcripts through the Fall 2010 semester

Graduate and professional school students who have completed at least two (2) years of graduate school are required to submit graduate transcripts, as well as Graduate work completed during the Fall 2010 semester.
